Up on the Roof

If you are looking for a room with a view, you may want to consider the Philip House on the Upper East Side. The classic prewar, brick-and-limestone 11-story building, built in 1927, offers 71 spacious and elegant condominiums, including the majestic Penthouse Diraboval, currently on the market for \$11.5 million. Why the helpty price tag? Think: over 3,500 interior square feet with a wraparound landscaped roof terrace at 2,100 square feet, four bedrooms, 4.5 bethrooms and details such as crown moldings, coffered ceillings, wood-burning fireplaces and wide plank flooring.
